Grounds and Landscaping

Snow removal – only ½ way through the current budget.

Jim's info on adding water tap - \$8500 for the tap, plus a fixed charge for each square foot of irrigated land. \$27,000 total.

The tract F water bill for 2019 was ~\$1,000. In 2020 it was ~\$3,400. The board currently pays 3 homeowners along the greenbelt to use their water to irrigate the greenbelt. The board is investigating ways to get the greenbelt irrigation on a separate system so the HOA can have better control of water use.

Perhaps the HOA can meter the water line for the irrigation and subtract it from the residence water bill.

Financial Review

2021 -2022 Budget -

- Due to preparation for the annual dues, the budget was not reviewed in detail.
- Credit per household for pool is included in the bill
- ACH Acct will not occur this year. Our bank provided us with inaccurate information regarding fees.
- The HOA board is looking into electronic storage of HOA records. File system, etc.. It can be stored on the HOA website server

Architectural Control – 3 requests. 1 new fence, concrete work, and exterior doors were approved. No complaints to the HOA

Pool

Possibilities for opening -

- Managed by Clean Pool.
- HOA will move forward to open the pool, but will follow State of Colorado mandates.
